

IMPORTANT: Due to constant improvements in vehicle design and quality, changes to a vehicle configuration may occur which can affect the Owner's Manual information after the supply for production has already been printed.

A error was discovered in the 2023 CFORCE 400/500 Owner's Manual on page 150 after the supply was already inserted into production.

CFMOTO ATVs do not come with a funnel, extension tube, or tube adapter as described in items #16 and #17 of the oil change instructions. Please refer to the page below for the corrected instructions:

MAINTENANCE
15. Use a dry and clean cloth to wipe the area around magnetic drain bolt.
16. Add the recommended type of oil into oil dipstick hole until the level is in the specified range.
17. Verify the oil level is between the upper and lower mark with the dipstick, and adjust the oil level accordingly.
⚠ CAUTION
Too much or too little oil will have an impact on the normal operation of the engine. Make sure the oil is maintained between the upper and lower marks of the dipstick.
18. Install and tighten the oil dipstick.
19. Verify the vehicle is in parking state, then start and idle the vehicle for 30 seconds.
20. Inspect the engine for leaks after turning off engine. Contact your dealer if leaks are found.
⚠ WARNING
When changing engine oil, turn off the vehicle and keep it in parking position to avoid injury or death.
21. Dispose the used oil and filter properly.
